Dear Parents /Guardians,

I hope this letter finds you and your family safe and well. I am delighted that school has now opened for the new term and it is wonderful to see our pupils back in school, where they belong. We welcome especially the new pupils, parents and carers who have joined us as part of our year 7 intake and those pupils who have joined us in other year groups. We wish them all the very best at Holy Trinity and are delighted to welcome you all as part of our school community, where we 'Learn to Love, Love to Learn.'

This letter contains information about the necessary arrangements to increase the time which your child will be spending in school as we move further into the school term. As you will know, these first two weeks have been an important re-introduction to school, an opportunity for pupils to get to know their new classes and year group 'bubbles' and to learn about and to understand the changes in how schools and year groups will operate as we move into the 'new normal' world. All pupils will be completing a wellbeing survey over the coming weeks and we continue to work hard to maintain, as a key priority the health, safety and wellbeing of all staff and pupils all in line with statutory health and safety guidance and advice for schools.

Our start and finish times will remain staggered to ensure a safe opening and exit for all pupils. As the timetable changes, all children will remain in their year group bubble for the duration of their time in school. Interaction with children from other year groups will continue to be restricted and in the majority of cases non-existent.

Having had a successful first two weeks back, with effect from next week we will be moving to a more broad and balanced curriculum. Pupils will remain in their bubbles but will increase both the range of subjects and also the amount of time they spend in school. Please see below for the changes in times of the school day. Year groups will have staggered start and finish times but will be in school every day.
