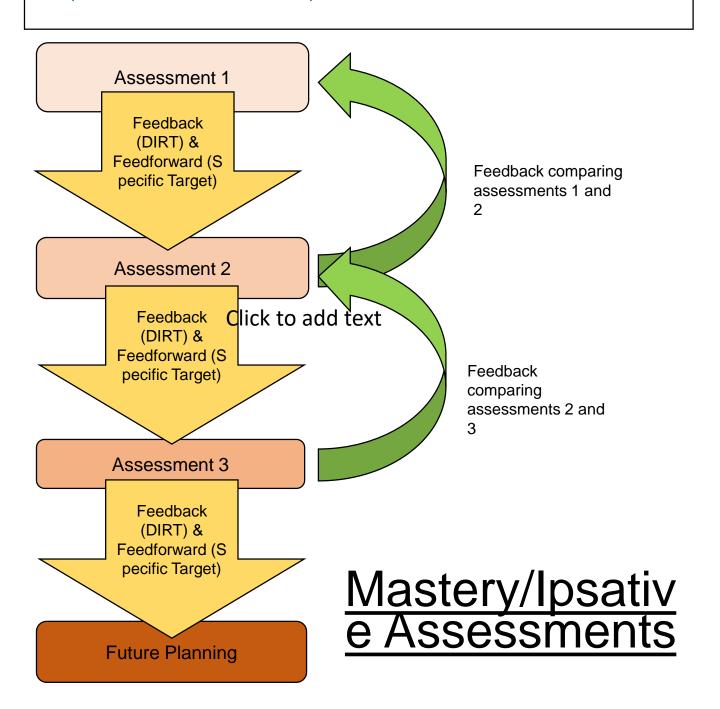

- The move towards Ipsative assessments will allow students to work on specific feedback over a two assessments before the final teacher assessed grade.
- This should allow students the ability to 'master' skills as they move through the curriculum and key stages

- · Assessments build on previous years

- Students to complete a combination of Language and literature assessments across the key stage

### **Assessment Journey**

Teachers are expected to track the students' assessment journey through teacher marked assessments, DIRT tasks, and Self-Assessed tasks. In addition to this, students should complete alterative assessments in their assessment books to map their developing understanding of the taught topic.
