During this time of year we would like to remind parents/ carers that it is important that all students remain well hydrated and take sensible precautions to keep themselves safe (this may include the application of sun cream, taking shelter in the shaded part of the playground, eating a suitable breakfast etc.). We are aware that a number of our Muslim students are about to begin their fast next week. We would like to reassure parents and carers of our support for your sons and daughters at this time.
